#### The Front Page

June 8, 2013. That is the Club's 50th anniversary date. As mentioned in previous communications, plans are underway to celebrate this momentous occasion on that weekend next year. We will continue to update members throughout the coming year with this Tee Talk starting the countdown to our 50<sup>th</sup>.

Here and now the golf season is well underway. The grounds crew has been busy continuing work on projects to tidy up some of the adverse effects of the weather this past winter and even from last year. The drainage work has helped providing them an opportunity to cut fairways and rough more often but the lack of summer weather thus far still has them slightly behind schedule on project work. The Greens Committee Chair and the Superintendent have prepared a prioritized project list that will be addressed when conditions and resources become available. The work completed thus far shows well (hole #3, fountain at the putting green, #13 green approach to name a few). The crew will also be sanding the fairways over the course of the next three weeks as part of our ongoing drainage enhancements. This will not require any closures. In keeping with the Board's commitment to communicate the Club's state of affairs to the membership, it is important to indicate where we are fiscally at this time of year. Going back to the start of our fiscal year, October 1st 2011, we've had a higher than projected membership attrition. Our uptake of new members has matched our projections, but unfortunately this does not make up for the higher than expected loss of members going back to the start of the fiscal year. This has an unfavorable effect on the Club's dues revenue thus far this year. On the other hand, our tournament bookings are significantly better than

last year which means our guest fee revenue should hit this year's projections (provided the weather improves and our daily guest fee visits meet targets). The food & beverage department is showing a strong income performance so far this year and should exceed the budget for the fiscal year. However these areas will not generate enough additional revenue to make up for the lower than projected dues income. A couple of months ago the Board initiated an action plan to probe for ways generate more income to offset the effect of lower than budgeted dues revenue. There are some promising options that are being explored by management that could go a long way towards assisting the Club's income for the fiscal year. They are currently undertaking the necessary due diligence on one specific concept. However, we are not in a position to make any announcement at this time. If all works out as expected, complete information on this initiative should be available early next month. In the meantime, we are asking members to assist us with a couple of very important aspects of being a successful member-owned club. Membership recruitment is the most important contribution you can make to your Club. We are always striving to welcome people to our golf family and there is no better way to introduce them than through our existing members. Please contact Laurie Shong or Mike Pierce if you know of anyone that may have an interest in becoming a golf club member. It is a challenging time for the private club industry but there is some optimism in the country to go along with the reality of the situation. Members are also encouraged to bring guests out to the Club. There are many opportunities to introduce people to the golf course at very attractive guest fee rates; this is especially true if you take advantage of our Monday & Thursday guest pass booklets.
